To save paper and reduce costs all of the questions and answers are on one page.

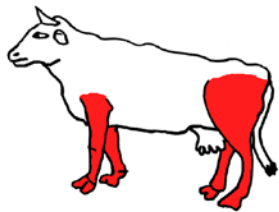
The page is laid out in a grid style and the page should be cut along these lines to separate the questions from the answers.

Each section should be trimmed so that when mounted on Red card a Red border is visible.

Each card should be the same size as the cards used for the pictures of Parts of the Cow.

Work Card

1. On what part of the body would you find the nostrils?
2. How many horns does the cow have?
3. Name the part of the cow highlighted in the picture below.



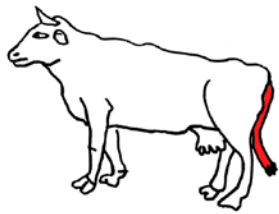
4. What does the cow use its tail for?

Answer Card

1. The nostrils can be found on the head.
2. The cow has two horns.
3. The legs are the part of the cow highlighted in the picture.
4. The cow uses its tail to drive away insects.

Work Card

1. How many toes does the cow have?
2. Is a cow a wild or domesticated animal?
3. Name the part of the cow highlighted in the picture below.



4. What does the cow use its udder for?

Answer Card

1. The cow has two toes.
2. The cow is a domesticated animal.
3. The tail is the part of the cow highlighted in the picture.
4. The cow uses its udder to feed its baby.

Work Card

1. In what part of the cow's body would you find the teats?
2. How many hooves does a cow have?
3. Name the part of the cow highlighted in the picture below.



4. Does the cow have a backbone?

Answer Card

1. The teats are found on the udder.
2. The cow has four hooves.
3. The head is the part of the cow highlighted in the picture.
4. The cow has a backbone as it is a vertebrate.

Work Card

1. In what part of the cow's body would you find the liver?
2. How many tails does a cow have?
3. Name the part of the cow highlighted in the picture below.



4. How many parts is the cow's stomach divided in to?

Answer Card

1. The liver is found in the body.
2. The cow has one tail.
3. The horn is the part of the cow highlighted in the picture.
4. The cow's stomach is divided in to 4 parts.
